A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AMENDMENT NO. 2 OF THE <u>FORWARD</u> <u>45</u> METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP) FOR THE PERMIAN BASIN METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO)

WHEREAS, Title 23 CFR Section 450.322, of the United States Code (U.S.C) requires Metropolitan Planning Organizations to complete a long-range transportation plan for a period of not less than 20 years; and

WHEREAS, the Forward 45 MTP was adopted on November 18, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the *Forward 45* MTP needed to be amended to include a revised priority project list, updated maps, and financial forecast where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Permian Basin MPO held a public meeting on September 7, 2021 to receive public comment regarding the *Forward 45* MTP Amendment No. 2; and

WHEREAS, a Record of Public Participation for the *Forward 45* MTP that reflects all efforts made by the Permian Basin MPO to inform and directly involve the public in the transportation planning process, is provided under Attachment "A" and is made part of this Resolution.

Record of Public Participation

The Public Participation process included:

- The Permian Basin MPO conducted a public meeting at the Permian Basin MPO
 Conference Room on Thursday, January 2, 2020 at 8:30 AM for the public to review and
 comment on the draft FY 2019-2022 TIP Amendment No. 2. Notice of the public meeting
 was placed in the Midland Reporter-Telegram and the Odessa American newspapers
 and on the MPO's website.
- The public was given a minimum of ten (10) days to submit comments on the projects for consideration prior to the adoption of the FY 2019-2022 TIP Amendment No. 2.
- A draft FY 2019-2022 TIP Amendment No. 2 was made available during regular business hours at the Permian Basin MPO Office; TxDOT Odessa District Office; the Midland and Ector County Libraries; the Martin County Courthouse, the City Secretary Offices of the Cities of Midland and Odessa; and on the Permian Basin MPO website (www.permianbasinmpo.com).
- In a regularly scheduled meeting of the Permian Basin MPO Policy Board Monday, January 13, 2020 the final FY 2019-2022 TIP Amendment No. 2. was approved for submission into the TxDOT Statewide TIP (STIP) on or before January 28, 2020. Citizens were again given the opportunity to review and comment on the FY 2019-2022 TIP Amendment No. 2 prior to the final approval by the Policy Board.
- The approved documents and any amendments will remain on the Permian Basin MPO website for ongoing reference by the public.
